### Irish Skater uses the impairment compensation under the Rondinelli Guide

In January 2011, the Ice Skating Association of Ireland held a National test session and a skater used the Rondinelli scale to obtain a compensation for their impairment. The ISAI rules allow a skater to obtain a compensation for impairment calculated under the Guides to the Evaluation of Permanent Impairment, 6th Edition. The skater with an impairment participated on an equal basis with other skaters, their ice skating was assessed impartially and the skater was fully integrated with all the non-impaired skaters.
