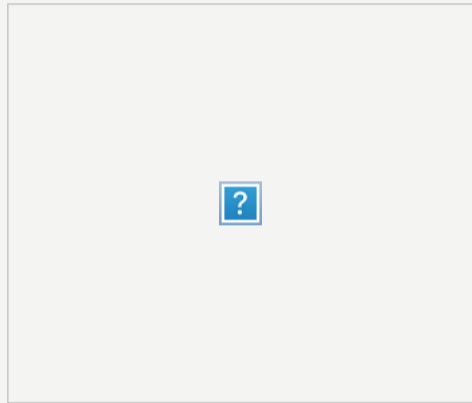

Originally Margarita undertook to build an international team of experts to develop the ideas and deliver a full and detailed plan to the ISU in 2012. The ISU did not adopt the format in 2012 and Inclusive Skating has therefore developed into an independent movement with world rankings and international events and national championships independently of the ISU. In 2018 the ISU recognised the Inclusive Skating format and thanked Margarita for her work to develop Inclusive skating. The Glasgow 2019 Inclusive skating event appears on the ISU calendar for the first time. So, Margarita looks forward to working in co-operation with the ISU and all relevant Federations in the future.
